To continue to build partnerships with our local community, the Sustainability Student Leadership team recently met with a representative from The Subiaco Rotary Club and are working towards making our school part of the Greenbatch Foundation. The students will have more information about how this will work for our school and community in the weeks to come.

Protective Behaviours Education

Health lessons in Term 4 will focus on teaching Protective Behaviours as directed by the Western Australian Curriculum. Lessons will be based on “Holding Hands” Protective Behaviours Program. The program is based on two themes:

- We all have the right to feel safe at all times
- We can talk with someone about anything, no matter what it is.

The idea of the program is to help students recognise when they do not feel safe and what steps to take if they need to seek help. This includes cyber safety for our students in Years 4-6.
