### **Subiaco Primary School Pool**

Subiaco Primary School is very fortunate to have a beautiful pool which all primary school families and general community members can use and enjoy. All you need to do is become a member - it's that easy!

The pool season runs from Friday, 27 November 2020 to Sunday, 14 March 2021. It is the perfect place to cool down with the kids over the hot summer months with shaded lawn and gardens, BBQ facilities and a Royal Life Saving Guard on duty at all times. It is open every day during the season apart from public holidays. That's almost 4 months of summer fun.

A season membership card is \$160, which entitles you and your immediate family to visit the pool as many times as you like. Alternatively, you can purchase a ten visit pass for \$45. A pass is required for each person attending the pool, regardless of age and whether they are swimming or supervising.

How to buy your membership or ten visit passes - We recommend you purchase your membership now so you can maximise your use of the pool as soon as it opens and not waste lovely summer days sitting around at home with bored and hot kids. Pool Parties - Enjoy exclusive use of the pool! The pool can be booked for pool parties on Saturdays, Sundays and during the school holidays between 9:00am to 1:00pm for a minimum 2 hours at \$110 per hour. A Royal Life Saving Australia life guard is included in the cost and will be present for the duration of the party.
