National Tree Day

On Wednesday, 26 July, students from Rooms 1, 2, 5 & 6, helped plant 100 local native seedlings around our school grounds with Todd and Chaplain Katie, as part of National Tree Day, Australia's largest community tree planting and nature care event. The program is a call

to action for all Australians to get their hands dirty and give back to their community. See attachment.

On Tuesday, we were also delighted to partner with The City of Subiaco, who donated 500 seedlings that are endemic to the region (Karrakatta vegetation complex). Last year, we focused a lot on creating the future upper canopy by planting trees and large growing species. This year, we chose groundcovers (to supress weeds, act as a natural mulch, reduce heat, and limit storm water runoff – particularly important with increasing climate change), and hardy grassy lower canopy species (good for bugs and ground dwelling fauna, assist with shading/cooling the ground, blue banded bees love Dianella revoluta too). All these plants have extensive aboriginal history and usage too.

Topic: Blokes do ask for help

As fathers and father figures, it's so easy to get lost in our other roles and forget what our first job is. Yet being a dad is the most important job we'll ever do. What we do, or don't do as dads, has an enormous impact on the happiness and health of the kids we love. Yes, it's a big job. But you don't have to go it alone. Some men feel reluctant to seek help when they are unsure about the severity of a problem, citing concerns such as embarrassment, or not wanting to appear weak by unnecessarily seeking help.

Anxiety and depression are like any other medical condition – you need ways to manage them and recover. Make an appointment and take your list of symptoms to your family doctor (GP). Your doctor is a good source of information and can assess if what you are feeling is anxiety or depression. Sometimes these conditions are experienced together. If you are diagnosed with one of these conditions, or both, together you can work out an action plan.
